


## 2022 Additional Varieties:

**ASPEN**, 'Summer Shimmer' – Pyramidal in shape with slightly larger, two-tone leaves than regular Quaking Aspen. White bark & bright golden yellow Fall color. Full sun. Tolerates wet & dry soils. Zone 3. (50'x35')



BALD CYPRESS, 'Lindsey's Skyward'™ - A scaled-down version of the 'Shawnee Brave'; not as tall & more narrow. Fine textured needles turning to rusty orange in Fall. Ideal for small gardens or privacy screen. Non-aggressive roots. Zone 5. Limited quantity available. (20'x6')

BIRCH, 'Prairie Dream®' – This Paper Birch is upright-oval becoming broadly oval with age. Moderately fast grower. Showy snow-white exfoliating bark and dark green leaves turning beautiful yellow in Fall. More adaptable & stress tolerant than other Birch. Highly resistant to bronze birch borer. Deer resistant. Zone 2b. (45'x35') Available Fall 2022. Limited quantity available.





**BIRCH**, 'Renaissance Oasis' – A large, broadly pyramidal Paper Birch tree that has improved drought tolerance and more pH resistance than other birch. Mahoganyaccented exfoliating bark reveals attractive white bark earlier than other varieties. Resistant to bronze birch borer. Rapid

grower. Zone 3. (50'x30') Available Fall 2022. Limited quantity available.



**BIRCH,** 'Royal Frost' – A mid-sized accent tree with burgundy-red leaves turning to yellow-orange-red in Fall. White bark. Fast grower. Upright, pyramidal form. Needs regular watering. Zone 3. (35'x20')

BIRCH trees tolerate full sun but also prefer afternoon shade & moist soil. Mulch trees well.

**BIRCH**, 'Shiloh Splash' – A narrow, compact ornamental river birch with variegated green & creamy white foliage. Exfoliating bark is added interest. Yellow fall color most years. Zone 4. (25'x12') Available Fall 2022. Limited quantity available.



BUDDLEIA, 'Miss Violet' Butterfly Bush – A compact, mounding habit with arching stems of vibrant dark purpleviolet flower clusters from summer to fall. Non-invasive. Full sun. Zone 5. (4'-5' tall & wide)

**CRABAPPLE**, 'Marilee'® - A good alternative to the fruitless 'Spring Snow' Crabapple. This upright, narrow ornamental is virtually fruitless and smaller in stature than the Spring Snow. Pink buds open to unusually large, white, double blooms. Inverted cone-shaped tree. Green leaves. Zone 4. (24'x10') Available Fall 2022. Limited quantity available.





**DOGWOOD,** 'Arctic Fire® Red', Red-Osier – A deciduous shrub that gives you winter color with its beautiful red stems. A dwarf variety that tolerates a wide range of soil & light conditions. White summer flowers, dark green foliage turning red in fall, red stems in winter. Full sun to part shade. Zone 3. *Limited quantity available*. (3'-5' tall & wide)







**DOGWOOD**, 'Garden Glow'™ - Chartreuse-yellow leaves turning to rosy-red/burgundy in Fall. Stems are red year-round. Small white flower clusters. Cold-hardy. Plant in areas of light shade to dappled sun. If planted in heavy shade, leaves will be dark green. Zone 4. (4'x5' tall & wide). *Limited quantity available*.





**LILAC**, 'Dwarf Korean' – Fragrant, lilacpink flowers in late Spring. Dark green leaves. <u>Tree-form</u>. Prefers full sun. (max. 5'x6')

tolerant. Zone 3. (max. 6' tall
but can be pruned to size).



**GINKGO**, 'Princeton Sentry' – A narrow, pyramidal shaped tree perfect as a street tree or for a small yard. Unique fan-shaped green leaves. Bright yellow Fall color. Full sun. Zone 4. *Available Fall 2022*. (40'x15')



**GINKGO**, 'Golden Colonnade'® - Narrow, oval shape. Medium green leaves have unique fan-shape and turn bright yellow in Fall. Full sun. Zone 4. (45'x25')

Limited quantity available.




## Japanese Maple Trees

**Bloodgood** – Upright, broad shaped tree with burgundy foliage. Reliable & versatile species. Red Fruits in late Summer/early Fall. Prefers sun or part shade. Protect from winter winds. Zone 5. (18'x18')





**MAPLE**, Crimson Sentry – This mid-size tree is ideal for narrow spaces. Plant in front of evergreens or light-colored structures for optimal effect. Dense purple/maroon leaves all growing season. Columnar shape maturing to pyramidal-oval. Zone 4. (25'x15') *Available Fall 2022* 









**OAK**, 'Corky Bark' Bur – An unusual Bur Oak selection that gets a heavily furrowed bark at an earlier age. It will also develop acorns at a younger age that are quite large & have a decorative fringe cap. Moderate growth rate of 12" or more/year. Zone 4. (55'x45') *Available Fall 2022*.

**OAK**, 'Prairie Stature'® - Dark green leaves through Summer with shades of orange/red, eventually tancolored by late Fall. Moderate growth rate (12" per year). Broadly-pyramidal shape. Adapts well to variety of soil textures & pH levels in upper Midwest. A hybrid between English and White Oak. Give it space and plenty of sun. Zone 3. (50'x40')

Small size available at Davenport, NE location. Limited availability.





**OAK**, 'Shumard' – A stately Oak with beautiful Fall color of orange-red. Pyramidal when young turning to rounded. Fast-growing, 1-2 ft/year. Produces acorns at approx. 25 yrs of age every 2-4 years. Full sun preferred. Tolerates compacted soil and some drought. Prefers acidic soil. Zone 5. (50'x40') *Available Fall 2022.* 





**SPIRAEA**, 'Neon Flash' – Vibrant cherryred flowers from Spring through Fall. Butterflies love them! Full sun. Average watering in well-drained soil. Zone 4. (2.5'x3')

**SWEETGUM,** 'Slender Silhouette' – An excellent choice for spectacular fall color! Plant a row for a living fence if you want a privacy screen. Very tall & narrow and low-branching. Produces a small amount of spiky ball fruit that can be easily gathered at the narrow tree base. Grows rather quickly with adequate watering. *Limited quantity available*. Zone 5. (45'x6')









columnar Tulip Tree ('Arnold') – Known as the "tallest-growing deciduous tree in No. America", this stately tree needs its own space! Tall & narrow with large leaves. Tulip-shaped blooms appear late Spring/early Summer. Fall color is golden yellow. Prefers full sun and acidic, well-drained soil. Zone 5. (50'x20')



**TUPELO**, Black – A medium-sized tree providing stunning Fall color on glossy leaves. Mature bark resembles alligator hide. Blue-black berries provide food for the birds. Prefers acidic, well-drained soil and minimum of 4 hours sunlight. Great for bees & honey! *Available Fall 2022 in limited quantity.* Zone 5/4. (40'x25')






**TUPELO**, 'Wildfire' – A double flash of fire from this variety! Leaves emerge tipped in red before turning a glossy dark green for Summer. A showy display of yellow, orange & crimson red in Fall. Needs acidic soil and sun for maximum color. Zone 4 (provide some winter protection if possible). (45'x30')





**SPRUCE**, 'Royal Splendor' Norway – A striking landscape specimen with upsweeping branches and a brighter emerald-green needle. Maintains a narrowly-pyramidal shape without drooping. Full sun. Tolerant of higher PH soils. Medium to fast growing. Zone 3. (40'x25')







**SPRUCE**, 'Wells Deer Run' – This narrow, upright tree is more blue than green in color with showy pendulous cones in the Spring. Full sun to part shade. *Limited quantity available*. (20'x 8')



**SPRUCE**, 'The Blues' Colorado – A weeping tree with bright powder-blue needles on irregular branching. Staked for height. Prefers full sun. Slow-growing. Zone 3. (8'x8')





**SPRUCE**, 'Blue Diamond' – Intense light-blue needles with silver overlay. It has a neat, upright, pyramidal shape. Prickly needles & long cylindrical cones. Grows about 4"/year. Zone 3-4. (30'x15')

**SPRUCE**, 'Blue Thunderbolt™ - A variation of Black Hills Spruce. Dense, conical shape with rich blue needles. Full sun. Zone 2. *Limited quantity available*. (35'x30')





**SPRUCE**, 'Columnar Black' – Upright, very narrow conifer with dense, bluegreen needles. Slow-grower. Prefers full sun. Zone 3. *Limited quantity available*. (20'x6')

SPRUCE, 'Hudson' a/k/a Hudsonii Alberta Spruce – A dwarf spruce with beautiful, short blue needles. This is a rare form of White Spruce with dense needling. Bright ornamental cones appear in Spring. Slow-grower. Needs full sun & well-drained soil. Adaptable to pH levels. Zone 3. (6'x4' in 10 years)









**SPRUCE**, 'Thompsen Blue' – This variety might have the palest icy-blue needles of all spruce! Dense, pyramidal form similar to the Hoopsii Spruce but with thicker needles. Branches become more open with age. Needs full sun and well-drained soil. Zone 3. (40'x20')

**JUNIPER,** 'Blue Star' – This evergreen forms a mounded shape of bright, steel-blue foliage. Slowgrowing. Can be used as a ground cover. Full sun to light shade. Cold hardy. (2'x4')
